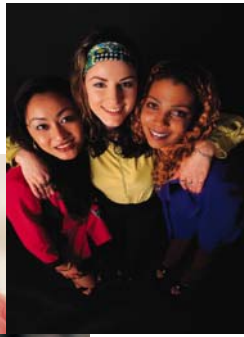


Suicide is the eleventh leading cause of death in the U.S., and the third leading cause of death for ages 10 to 24 years.
